## Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required by law to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Sebago qualified by law to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Town of Sebago at 9:00 a.m., Saturday, March 4, 2023, for a Special Town Meeting, to act on the following:

- Article 1. To choose a Moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Article 2. Shall an ordinance entitled "Amendments to the Land Use Ordinance of the Town of Sebago to Prohibit Quarrying in the Village and Rural Residential Districts" be enacted? (Copy attached; a majority of the Selectmen so recommend).
- Article 3. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$2,300 for installation of a Fuel Management System at the Town Garage.
- Article 4. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$6,000 for a transcriptionist to assist with the Zoning Board of Appeals Minutes in regards to the quarry issue.
- Article 5. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$5,000 for Remote meeting communications with video.
- Article 6. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$30,000 for Security System Improvements (DVI cameras, door controls, Internet, hooking up local networks between the Fire Station, Town Hall and Town Office buildings).
- Article 7. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$30,000 for Heat Pumps at the Town Office building.
- Article 8. To see if the Town will vote to expend a portion of the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (aka American Rescue Plan Act or ARPA funds) received by the Town from the federal government for:
  - \$5,500 for trainings and current manuals.
