## **Town Stickers**

As many of you know the Town Stickers are **Orange** this year. If you still have a square sticker with **Blue** lettering, please come get a new sticker or hanging tag at your earliest convenience.

Please remember that **each** vehicle that goes to the Transfer Station or the Town Beach needs a Town Sticker or Hanging Tag that matches the vehicles license plate number. There are no limits on how many Town Stickers you can have. The only requirement is that you are a Sebago Resident or Property Owner. If you are renting we will need to see a copy of your rental/lease agreement.

If you are renting your property to a guest there is a \$5.00 a week or \$20.00 per month fee for the Hanging Tag. You need to gather the following info:

The dates they will be here, the name of the person, the plate number of the vehicle they are using and the state the plate is from.

### **Ways to obtain a sticker:**

1. Come into the Town Office, during office hours, with your license plate number.
2. Mail a note with your Name, Sebago Address, Phone Number, License Plate Number (s), and a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope and we will mail the stickers back to you.

From the Assessor's: John E O'Donnell & Associates  
Sebago is conducting its first property revaluation in seventeen years. In the next few weeks O'Donnell & Associates will send letters to property owners. The value notice will provide a proposed assessed value and an estimated tax based on the new assessment. The letter will provide instructions for people that want to meet with or email us to discuss the proposed value. There are approximately 2,200 properties in Sebago. The goal of the revaluation is to improve equity in assessed values to ensure a fair distribution of Sebago's property tax burden.

### Tax Bills

Taxes will be committed in late August, and mailed by early September. If you do not receive your tax bill by October please give us a call (207) 787-2457.
