## MAILBOXES BEWARE

Often the question arises as to who is responsible for any damage to mailboxes during snow removal. The Town is not responsible for any damage to mailboxes being hit by the plow trucks. The reason is that mailboxes are usually placed in the Town or State right-of-way's. The bottom of mailboxes must be set approximately 54" from ground level to allow a plow wing attachment to pass under it. The upright mailbox post should be set back from the edge of pavement at least 24" with a horizontal support extending outward to allow a mail delivery vehicle to keep its tires on the pavement and still be able to reach the mailbox door. When the mailbox door is in the open position (tilted down), the outer most edge of the door should be plumb with the edge of the pavement.

## WINTER SALT/SAND AVAILABLE FOR SEBAGO RESIDENTS

Sebago residents and taxpayers may obtain salt/sand from the designated area in the lean-to building located in front of the Public Works Garage (and next to the EMS Building) to use only on their own property located in the Town of Sebago. Contractors shall not obtain or use any town salt/sand for commercial purposes.

## Christmas Tree Disposal

The Transfer Station will accept undecorated Christmas Trees during the holidays. Trees with decorations such as tinsel, garlands, etc., will not be accepted. You will need to have an **orange** or **green** transfer station sticker to drop off any Christmas trees.

## **Boat Registrations**

With snow on the ground and more storms coming the last thing we want to think about is boats.

But Boat registrations can be renewed in the office and online starting January 1, 2022. If you register online keep in mind that it will take the State some time to mail you the stickers. If you register in the office please bring:

1. Last years registration,
2. The ME # on the Hull or
3. The registration sticker #.

For NEW to you boats you will need to come into the office and bring with you:

1. A Bill of Sale that lists the Year, Make and Serial #, and
2. The ME # on the hull if it was registered in Maine by the seller.

## **ATV, & Snowmobile Registrations**

Please bring last years registration or sticker number for renewals.

## **Hunting/Fishing Licenses**

Please bring a copy of your previous hunting/fishing license. 2022 Hunting/Fishing licenses can be sold at this time.

## **Dog Licensing**

Began October 15. All dogs 6 months and older need to be licensed every year. Licenses can be obtained at the Town Office or online. You will need your dogs current rabies certificate. If you register your dog online you **will not** receive the tag until after the beginning of the next month. If you no longer have your dog for any reason, please give us a call (207) 787-2457 or email [adminassist@townofseboro.org](mailto:adminassist@townofseboro.org) so that we may remove your dog from our records and avoid a visit from the animal control officer.

Neuter/Spayed Dogs are \$6.00, Unaltered dogs are \$11.00.

The last day to register your dog (s) and avoid the \$25.00 per dog late fee is January 31, 2022.

## **Budget Committee**

Budget Committee meetings will be starting on January 5, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Town Office. Meetings are open to the public and will continue through February-March. The Budget Committee will review a budget that was prepared by the Town Manager and Department Heads in addition to service providers and civic groups.
