Town Stickers

As many of you know the Town Stickers are Orange this year. If you still have a square sticker with Blue lettering, please come get a new sticker or hanging tag at your earliest convenience.

Please remember that **each** vehicle that goes to the Transfer Station or the Town Beach needs a Town Sticker or Hanging Tag that matches the vehicles license plate number. There are no limits on how many Town Stickers you can have. The only requirement is that you are a Sebago Resident or Property Owner. If you are renting we will need to see a copy of your rental/lease agreement.

If you are renting your property to a guest there is a \$5.00 a week or \$20.00 per month fee for the Hanging Tag. You need to gather the following info:

The dates they will be here, the name of the person, the plate number of the vehicle they are using and the state the plate is from.

Ways to obtain a sticker:

- 1. Come into the Town Office, during office hours, with your license plate number.
- Mail a note with your Name, Sebago Address, Phone Number, License Plate Number (s), and a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope and we will mail the stickers back to you.

Burn Permits and Seasonal Campfire Permits

Burn Permits are required by law when you want to do any open burning during the year. Burn Permits can be obtained at <u>wardensreport.com</u>. This is a free service, you only need to be able to print out the permit. Because of the lack of manpower in Town permits will not be issued until 5:00 pm on weekdays and 10:00 am on weekends.

Also the website wont let you process a burn permit if the fire class for that day is too high.

Seasonal Campfire Permits can be obtained at the Town Office and are good for the calendar year. New permits are available as early as January 1 of each year.
