#### **Town Stickers**

As many of you know the Town Stickers are Orange this year. If you still have a square sticker with Blue lettering, please come get a new sticker at your earliest convenience.

Please remember that **each** vehicle that goes to the Transfer Station or the Town Beach needs a Town Sticker that matches the vehicles license plate number. There are no limits on how many Town Stickers you can have. The only requirement is that you are a Sebago Resident or Property Owner. If you are renting we will need to see a copy of your rental/lease agreement.

#### Ways to obtain a sticker:

- 1. Come into the Town Office, during office hours, with your license plate number.
- Mail a note with your Name, Sebago Address, Phone Number, License Plate Number, and a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope and we will mail the stickers back to you.

#### Transfer Station Information

If you have questions about what the Transfer Station accepts or what they charge for please call (207) 787-2176. The Transfer Station is open the T's and the S's (Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday) from 7am-5pm.

#### Licenses for ATVs, Boats and Snowmobiles

The Town of Sebago can process first-time and renewal registrations for ATVs boats, and snowmobiles for residents and non-residents.

To process a **first-time registratio**n for <u>any</u> of the above recreational vehicles, you will need:

• Bill of Sale—which should include seller's name, buyer's name, VIN/Serial number, Maine registration number (if previously registered in Maine), and the price of the recreational vehicle.

Sales Tax—is required for first-time registrations. Be prepared to pay 5.5% of the sales price on a new recreational vehicle. Please note: If your recreational vehicle is a used model and previously registered in Maine we will need the Maine registration number (ME number).

To process a renewal registration for any of the above recreational vehicle please present your <u>previous registration</u>, ME #, or Sticker # at renewal time.

## Registration Period

- All Boats expire December 31st of each year.
- ATV's and Snowmobiles expire June 30th of each year.

## **Burn Permits and Seasonal Campfire Permits**

Burn Permits are required by law when you want to do any open burning during the year. Burn Permits can be obtained at <u>wardensreport.com</u>. This is a free service, you only need to be able to print out the permit. Because of the lack of manpower in Town permits will not be issued until 5:00 pm on weekdays and 10:00 am on weekends.

Also the website wont let you process a burn permit if the fire class for that day is too high.

**Seasonal Campfire Permits** can be obtained at the Town Office and are good for the calendar year. New permits are available as early as January 1 of each year.
