Property Tax Exemptions

Homestead Exemption: If you have owned your house for a full calendar year and it is your primary residence you could qualify for the homestead exemption which will lower your tax amount by approximately \$200.00.

Veteran's Exemption: If you are a Veteran you could qualify for this exemption that could lower your tax amount approximately \$60.00.

Both forms are available at the Town Office and need to be submitted before April 1.

Motor Vehicle Registrations

New registrations must be done in the office by the titled owner the first time. Please bring:

- 1. Title or Title Application
- 2. Bill of Sale
- 3. Valid Proof of Insurance.

We stop processing <u>any</u> new registrations a half hour before we close.

Renewals can be done online or in the office. Please Bring:

- 1. Your most recent vehicle registration
- 2. Proof of Insurance
- 3. Current Mileage

Boat Registrations

Boat registrations can be renewed in the office and online starting January 1, 2022. If you register online keep in mind that it will take the State some time to mail you the stickers. If you register in the office please bring:

- 1. Last years registration,
- 2. The ME # on the Hull or
- 3. The registration sticker #.

For NEW to you boats you will need to come into the office and bring with you:

- 1. A Bill of Sale that lists the Year, Make and Serial #, Sellers name and Address and
- 2. The ME # on the hull if it was registered in Maine by the seller.

Please bring last years registration or sticker number for renewals.

Please bring a copy of your previous hunting/fishing license. 2022 Hunting/Fishing licenses can be sold at this time.
