Tax Bills

Taxes will be committed and mailed in September. If you do not receive your tax bill by mid-October please give us a call (207) 787-2457.

Under Maine law payment of property taxes is the responsibility of the person who owned the property on April 1, 2021. Tax bills are sent to the owner of record as of that date. Only one tax bill will be sent out in the fall with two payment stubs.

A REMINDER NOTICE WILL NOT BE SENT.

The new owner **WILL NOT** receive a tax bill. It is the responsibility of the former owner to forward the bill to the new owner. In the event that you sold your property after April 1st, the buyer and seller may agree to divide the taxes between them, but if any part of the taxes is not paid, a lien will be filed in the name of the person who owned the property on April 1st.
